Written description of the proposed route of the pipeline (map attached)

The Yarra Glen to Lilydale Pipeline commences at the APA Group Pakenham to Wollert 750 mm pipeline adjacent to the Yarra Glen City Gate and proceeds within Glenview Road Reserve to the Yarra River, crossing it into Spadonis Reserve on the southern side. It will then run in a southerly direction along Victoria Road for approximately 6.5 km, partially within private land. It includes the proposed Lilydale City Gate located in the Lilydale Memorial Park. From the City Gate it will be installed within Victoria Road to terminate at an existing Multinet Gas, Lilydale Regulator Station on the north side of the Maroondah Highway at its intersection with Victoria Road (Melways ref: 38 A6).

Details of the use to which the proposed pipeline will be put

To convey gaseous hydrocarbons from the 750mm Pakenham to Wollert pipeline (PL141), at an MAOP of 6,980 kPa to a gas regulator site to be located at the the Lilydale Cemetery and Memorial Park and at an MAOP of 2,760 kPa to the terminal of the 250mm Ringwood to Lilydale pipeline (PL 100) at the corner of Victoria Road and the Maroondah Highway, Lilydale. The purpose of the pipeline is to reinforce the supply of gas delivered by the PL 100 system.

Anticipated date for commencement of construction of the pipeline: 1 August 2011

Anticipated date for completion of construction of the pipeline: 31 December 2011
