Delivering natural gas to Warburton

Multinet Gas Extension Project

Who can connect to natural gas?

If gas mains are installed and operating in your street, you will be able to arrange connection. The map shows which streets are planned to have natural gas available. To facilitate connection, you must connect by entering into a contract with a gas retailer. Appliances must also be capable of taking natural gas supply, otherwise you will need to replace them.

Why do I need a gas retailer?

Multinet Gas is a gas distributor supplying natural gas to approximately 660,000 customers throughout Melbourne's inner and outer East including a number of towns in the Yarra Ranges. Your gas retailer is the company that will send you your gas bill. You will need to enter into a retail supply contract with your chosen retailer. Some gas retailers may offer you package deals by combining both your electricity and natural gas.

What is a gas service?

A gas service is the pipe that runs from the gas main in the street to the gas meter on your property. Please note that the gas service and meter location will be installed in accordance with the relevant gas codes.

What happens if I am not in one of the properties to be reticulated?

If you want to connect and there are no plans to install gas mains in your property, you can apply to a gas retailer requesting a connection. Multinet Gas will assess the costs in accordance with the Gas Distribution Code. It may be beneficial to make a group application to one retailer to make it more economically viable. Your gas retailer will inform you if any shortfall costs apply.

What will it cost me to connect if gas is available in my street?

Each application will be assessed by Multinet Gas in accordance with the Gas Distribution Code. The assessment will include the cost to provide a gas service, the proposed appliances and gas usage. The costs, if any, will be provided to your retailer and they will provide this to you (some gas retailers may have a connection charge).

What incentives are available to enable to connect?

Multinet Gas has financial incentives available to residents to encourage early connection to natural gas. A separate incentive brochure is available with the relevant details. Incentives are in the form of rebates and up to \$1,300 is available per property consisting of conversion costs (up to \$800) and purchase of a new gas appliance (up to \$500) once gas is connected. Further information is available on www.multinetgas.com.au. Note that financial incentives are not applicable to residents outside the Warburton Township.

Current gas retailers

Please note there are a number of current energy (gas) retailers. When you make your decision to connect to natural gas, you should refer to www.yourchoice.vic.gov.au which will give you up to date industry information regarding gas retailers in Warburton or call 1300 887 501 (Mon-Fri, 8:00am – 6:00pm).

Easy steps to connect to Natural Gas


1. Check the map enclosed to see if natural gas is available in your street and location (remember, if not see question 'What happens if I am not in one of the properties to be reticulated?').
2. Apply to an energy retailer for a gas service and retail supply contract and they will coordinate with Multinet Gas to install the gas service to your property.
3. You will need to arrange a gas fitter to assess the suitability of your gas appliances/fitting line and/or arrange a fitting line and arrange conversion to take supply of natural gas.
4. Your gas fitter will then coordinate with your energy retailer to arrange for installation of the meter and arrange the final connection.

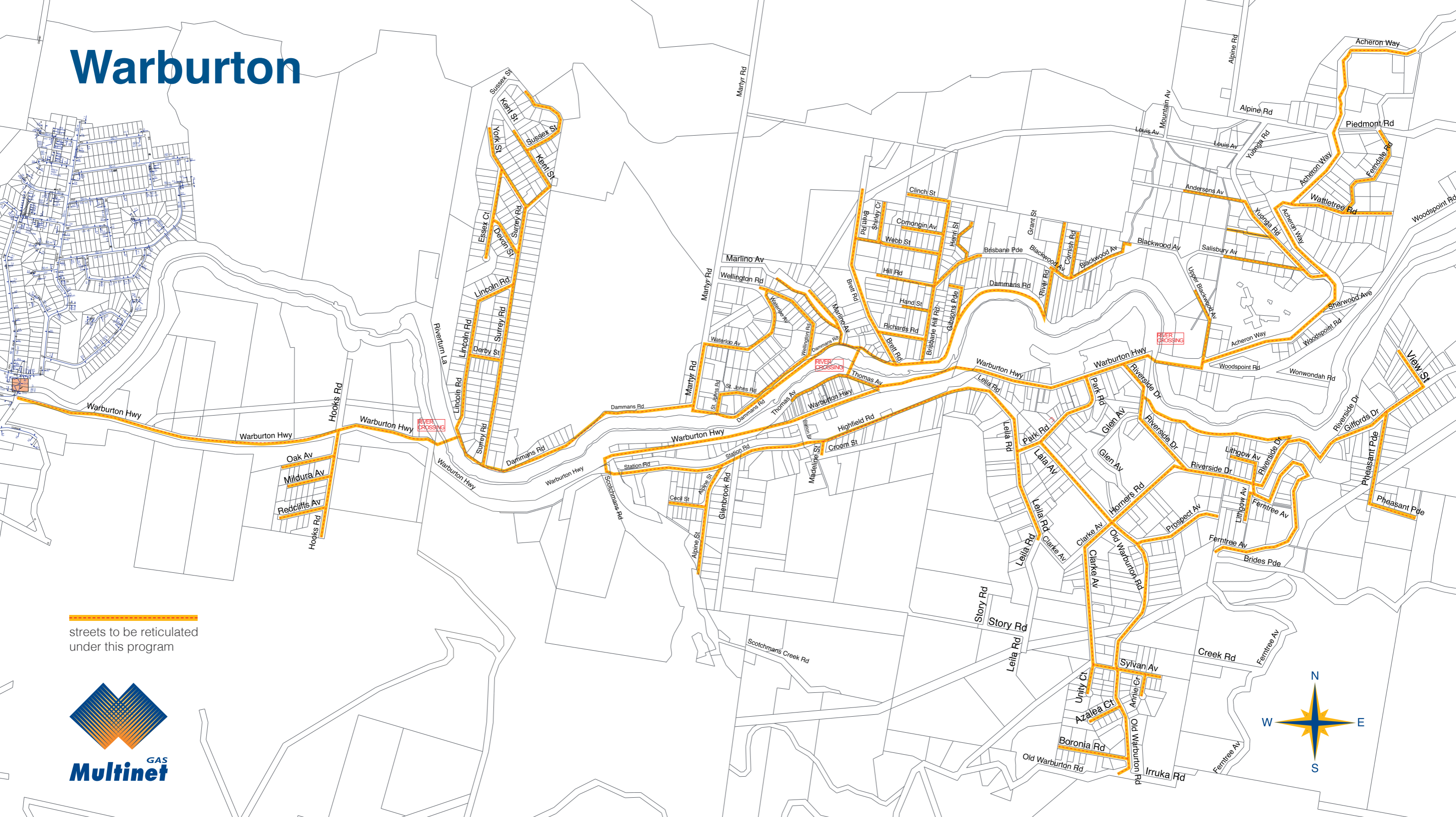
